

Hell 101

Luke 16:19-31

Christians who follow Jesus believe what Jesus believed. If we claim to “*follow Jesus*” and reject what He believed, we are not really following Jesus. This Bible study explores what Jesus believed about hell.

We use the King James Version but if you don't have a KJV you may use any Bible to look up the verses and answer the questions.

Jesus is teaching religious self-righteous Jews, Luke 16:15, who mocked His teachings, Luke 16:14. He tells the story of two men, one rich and outwardly blessed, the other a poor despised beggar without any visible blessings. According to Jesus, both men die and enter the afterlife.

2. When the rich man dies, where does he go according to Jesus? Luke 16:22-23. _____
3. According to Jesus, is hell a different place than the grave? Luke 16:22-23. _____
4. According to Jesus, is the rich man happy or tormented in hell? Luke 16:23. _____
5. According to Jesus, what does the rich man beg for in hell? Luke 16:24.

6. How does the rich man describe his situation in hell? Luke 16:24.

7. What caused the rich man's torment in hell according to Jesus in Luke 16:24? _____

8. How does father Abraham describe the rich man's situation in hell? Luke 16:25. _____

9. According to Jesus, is it possible for someone in hell to get out? Luke 16:26. **Yes No**

10. In Luke 16:19-31, how many times does Jesus use some form of the word **torment** to describe hell? Circle the correct number. **1 - 2 - 3 - 4**

11. According to Jesus, when we die, are we aware and conscious or asleep and unconscious? Luke 16:22-23. _____
